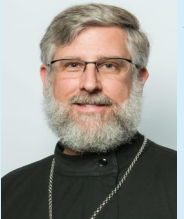

Vatican News

Installment of new Cardinals in Rome

Cardinal Justin Rigali, who now resides in the Diocese of Knoxville, fulfilled one of his many faithful duties to the Catholic Church by attending a consistory of the College of Cardinals at the Vatican at which Pope Francis officially created 14 new cardinals for the Church.

“This is the highest honor that we can receive, the greatest promotion that can be awarded us: to serve Christ in God’s faithful people. In those who are hungry, neglected, imprisoned, sick, suffering, addicted to drugs, cast aside,” Pope Francis said to the new cardinals.

Following the ceremony, the Church’s newest cardinals traveled a short distance to greet 91-year-old Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI.

The new cardinals come from Bolivia, Iraq, Italy, Japan, Pakistan, Poland, Portugal, Peru, Madagascar, Mexico and Spain. There are now 226 cardinals serving the Catholic Church.

On Friday, June 28, Cardinal Rigali participated in a Mass at the Vatican celebrating the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

In his Apostolic Exhortation, *The Word of the Lord*, Pope Benedict XVI reminds us that the Scriptures were written by a faith-filled community under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. Consequently, the Scriptures must be interpreted with this view in mind. However, certain modern scholars approach the Scriptures with preconceived notions that are hostile to the faith and divorce the text from its proper context. For instance, a fundamental premise underlying much of modern biblical scholarship is that the Divine does not intervene in human history. This premise completely negates the message and meaning of the Scriptures; and it largely explains many of the false statements we hear today that question the divinity of Jesus, the miracles He performed, and His real presence (Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity) in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Do not allow scholarship that is fundamentally flawed to seep into your mind and water down your faith. Approach the Eucharistic Jesus with awe and reverence during Mass and frequent Adoration

St. Therese Parish offers adoration and benediction after the 7:30 a.m. Mass on Fridays. All are welcome to attend.
